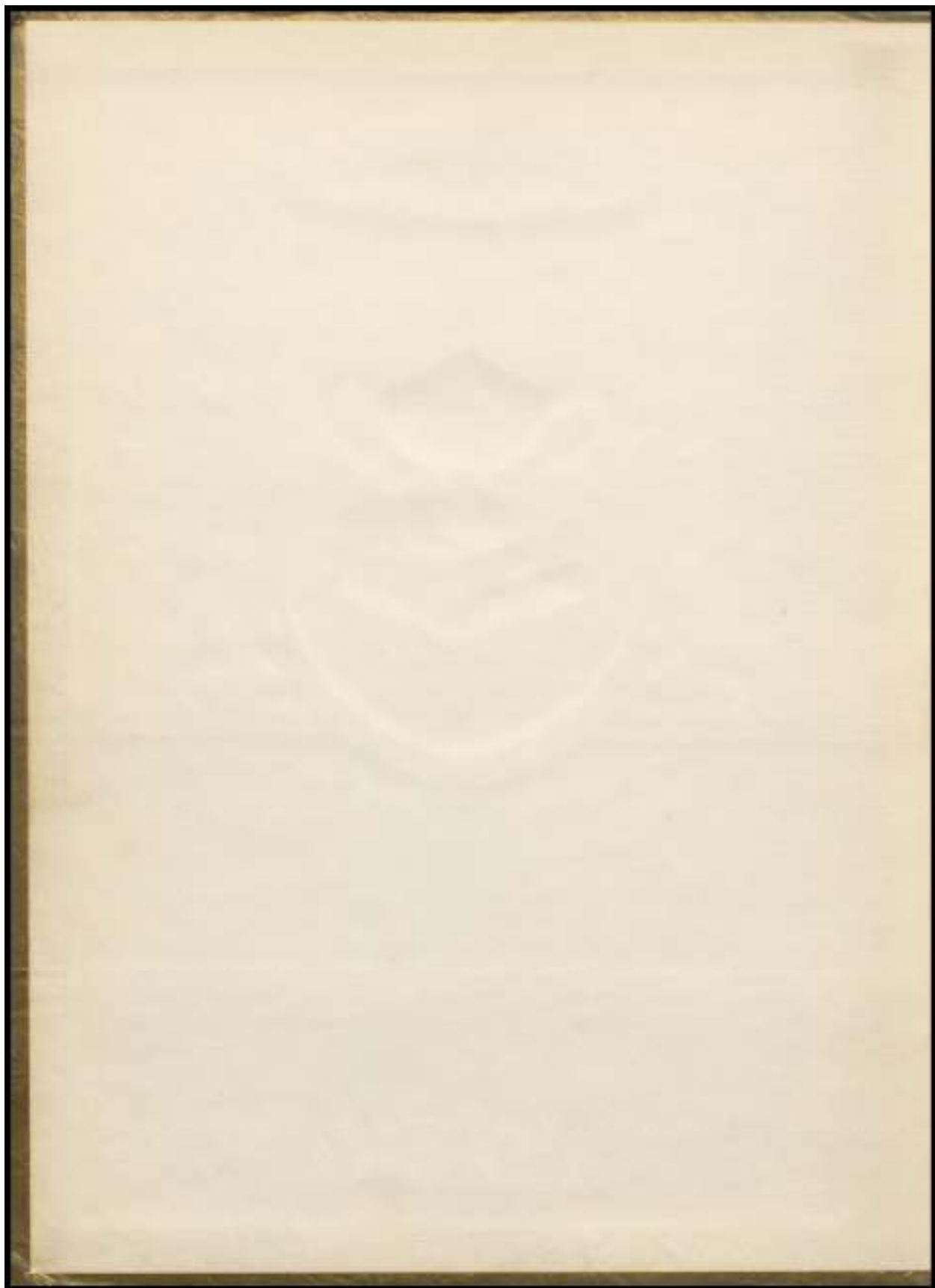
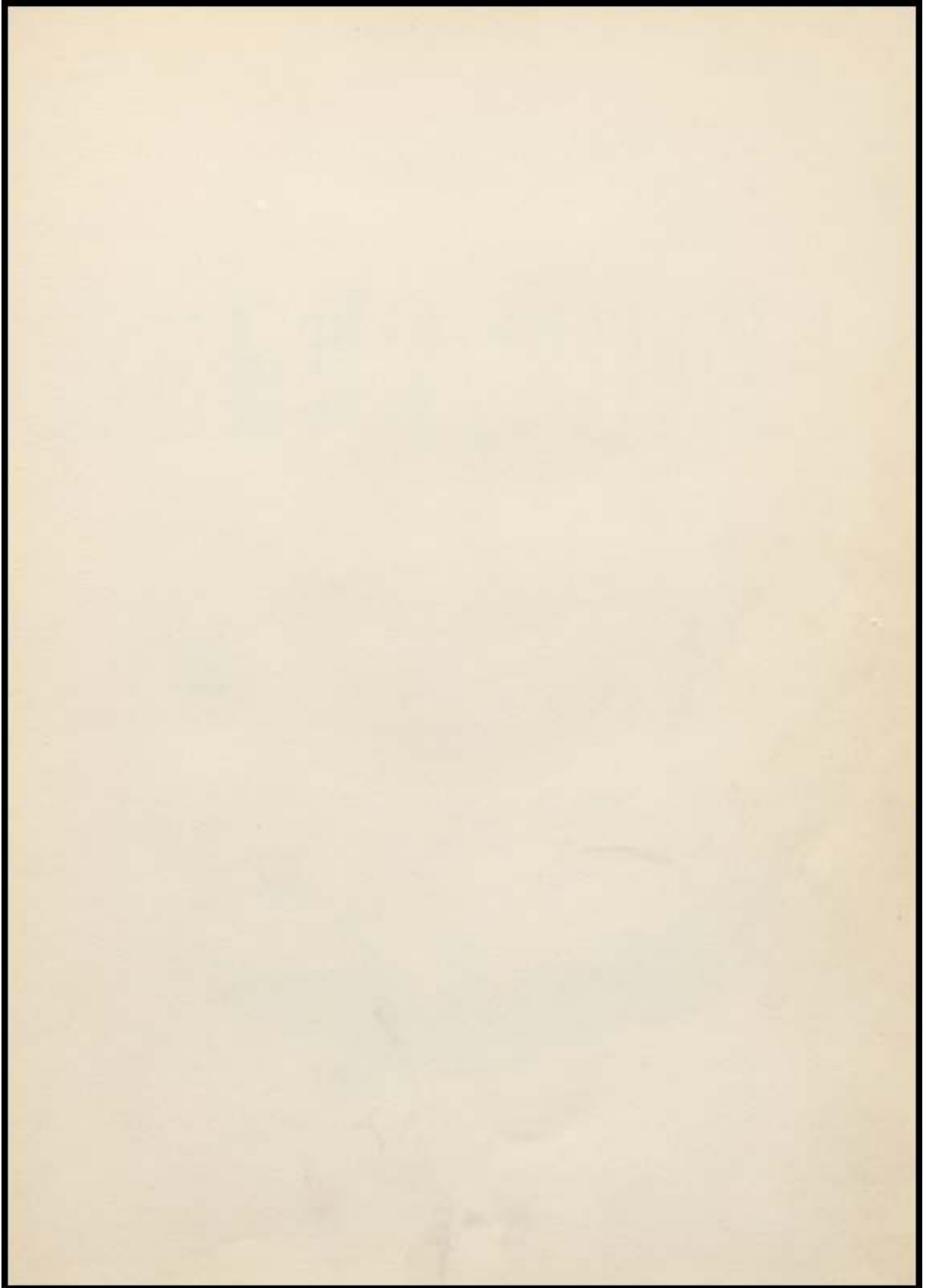


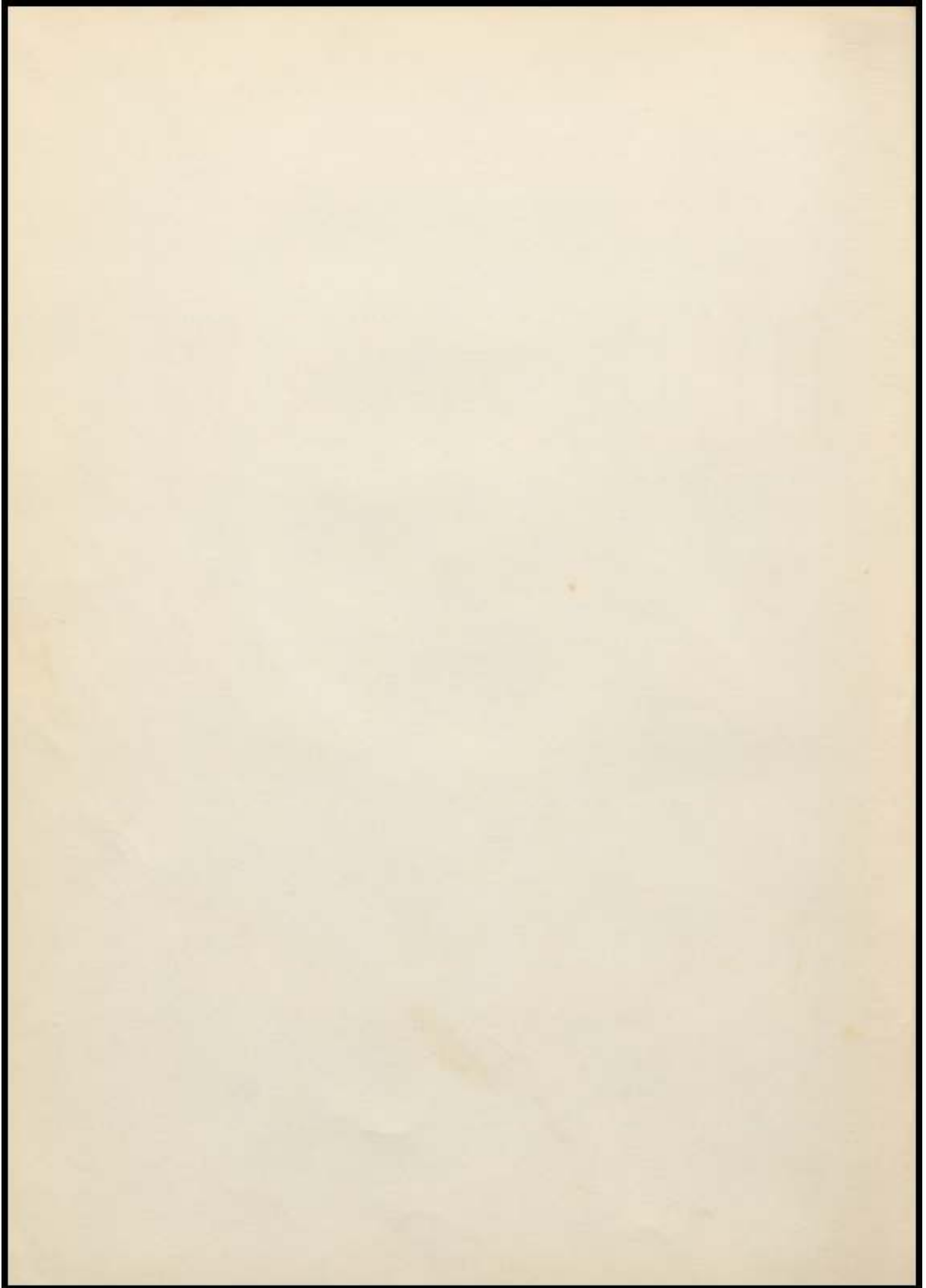

Class History

At the beginning of the second semester we moved over to make room for two more: Barbara Maxwell and Lucille Sween.

After a three month summer furlough we marched across the hall into second grade. Here we found that Wayne Vaudt, Ruth Christianson, Beverly DeSmidt, and Barbara Maxwell had dropped from our files. To take their place we added Phelva Berge, Arnold Bratland, Beverly Smith, Barbara Cottingham, and Ramona Courtney. This year Ruth Roseth kept us in line.

By the time we had invaded third grade we were quite accustomed to the golden rule. This year we were quite fortunate to lose only one member, Robin Besch. Through transfer from other camps we received Leon Albee, James Hanson, Marge Olson, and Ordean Tonderum and regained Barbara Maxwell. Bernice Estenson marched us through with little difficulty.

Next fall we again marched across the hall to fourth grade and found Nadine Shores waiting to greet us. Ralph Rolland and Harlan Sundermeyer joined our division but Phelva Berge, Arnold Bratland, Marlan Knutson, Barbara Maxwell, and Lucille Sween left us.

When we came to school the following year we found ourselves in the fifth grade. We found that our teacher had also been promoted. Miss Nadine Shores was now Mrs. Leroy Selvig. Here we gained Harold Bringman and Eleanor Satern and lost Leon Albee, Ramona Courtney, Jerry Christianson, Curtis Olson, LaVonne Rood, and Beverly Smith.

As we advanced to the sixth grade we found our little group joined by Melvin Cochran, Ethel Mae Cochran, and Lucille Sween. Harlan Sundermeyer was the only one that left us that year. Our studious tactics were supervised by our teacher, Ivanell Larson.

In seventh grade stricter rules and regulations were introduced by Mildred Carlson in the form of the monitor system. This year we gained Tommy Bauer, Howard Satern, and in the second semester, Devonna Kinseth. We lost Harold Bringman, Ethel Cochran, Melvin Cochran, and Barbara Cottingham.

We thought it quite thrilling when for the last time on first story we marched across the hall and pitched our camp in the eighth grade room. Mona Tullis helped us finish our initial training and we were ready for high school. We lost this year Tommy Bauer, Devonna Kinseth, James Hanson, Eleanor Satern, and Howard Satern; and gained Vivian Johnson.

On September 2, 1946, the following eighteen Freshmen took up residence in the high school assembly. They were Barbara Adams, Wanda Arne, Richard Barber, Rebecca Gangestad, Darwin Hacker, John Hanson, Vivian Johnson, Paul Lansing, Juanita Larson, Darlene Mitsven, Marge Olson, Norma Olson, Ralph Rolland, Juanita Selvig, Lucille Sween, Ordean Tonderum, Dolores Vaag, and Jerry Williams. We all survived the rigors of initiation and settled into the lives of servile Freshmen, under the sponsorship of Mr. Schar.

We then entered the lives of Sophomores. We were superior this year and were indeed happy to all share in the joy of initiating the Freshmen. This we did under the direction of our sponsor, Harry Kructen. During the mid-year we lost Darlene Mitsven and Ordean Tonderum.

The following year we took up the still higher part of Juniors. We enjoyed giving our Junior class play, "The Great Ben Allah" under the able direction of Mr. Dale Vige. During this year we lost Wanda Arne. We then had the great opportunity of putting on the Junior-Senior Banquet with the theme "Fairy Wonderland". This we did under the patient and helpful guidance of Miss Carrie Adamson.

Climbing even higher, we found ourselves in the important role of Seniors. We are very fortunate to have lost only three classmates. We are now looking forward to our trip on Skip Day; to once again under the direction of Mr. Dale Vige present our class play; and are all anxiously awaiting the Junior-Senior Banquet. On May 17, 1950, fifteen students will graduate from Bode Consolidated School. They are Barbara Adams, Richard Barber, Rebecca Gangestad, Darwin Hacker, John Hanson, Vivian Johnson, Paul Lansing, Juanita Larson, Marge Olson, Norma Olson, Ralph Rolland, Juanita Selvig, Lucille Sween, Dolores Vaag, and Jerry Williams.
