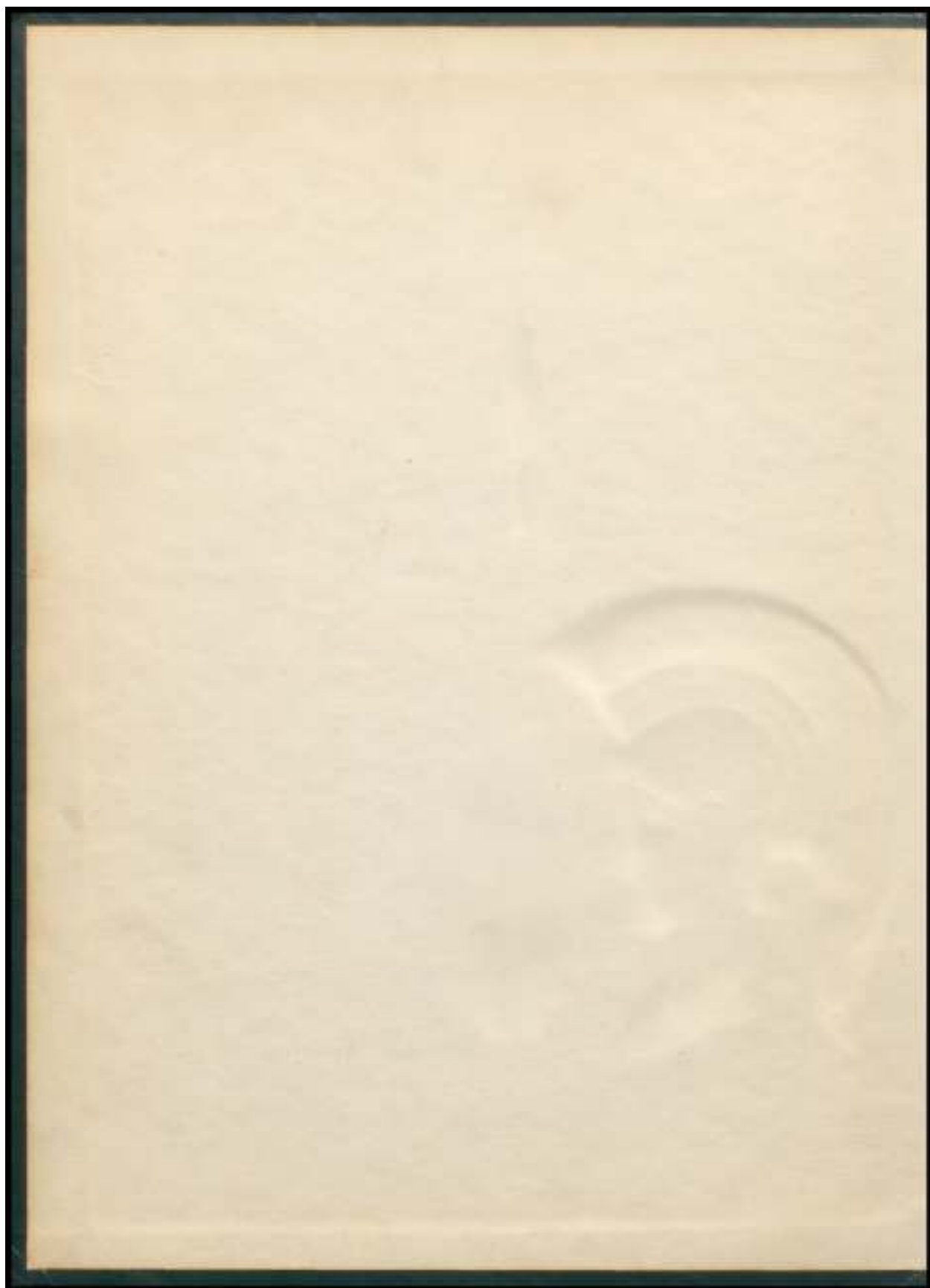
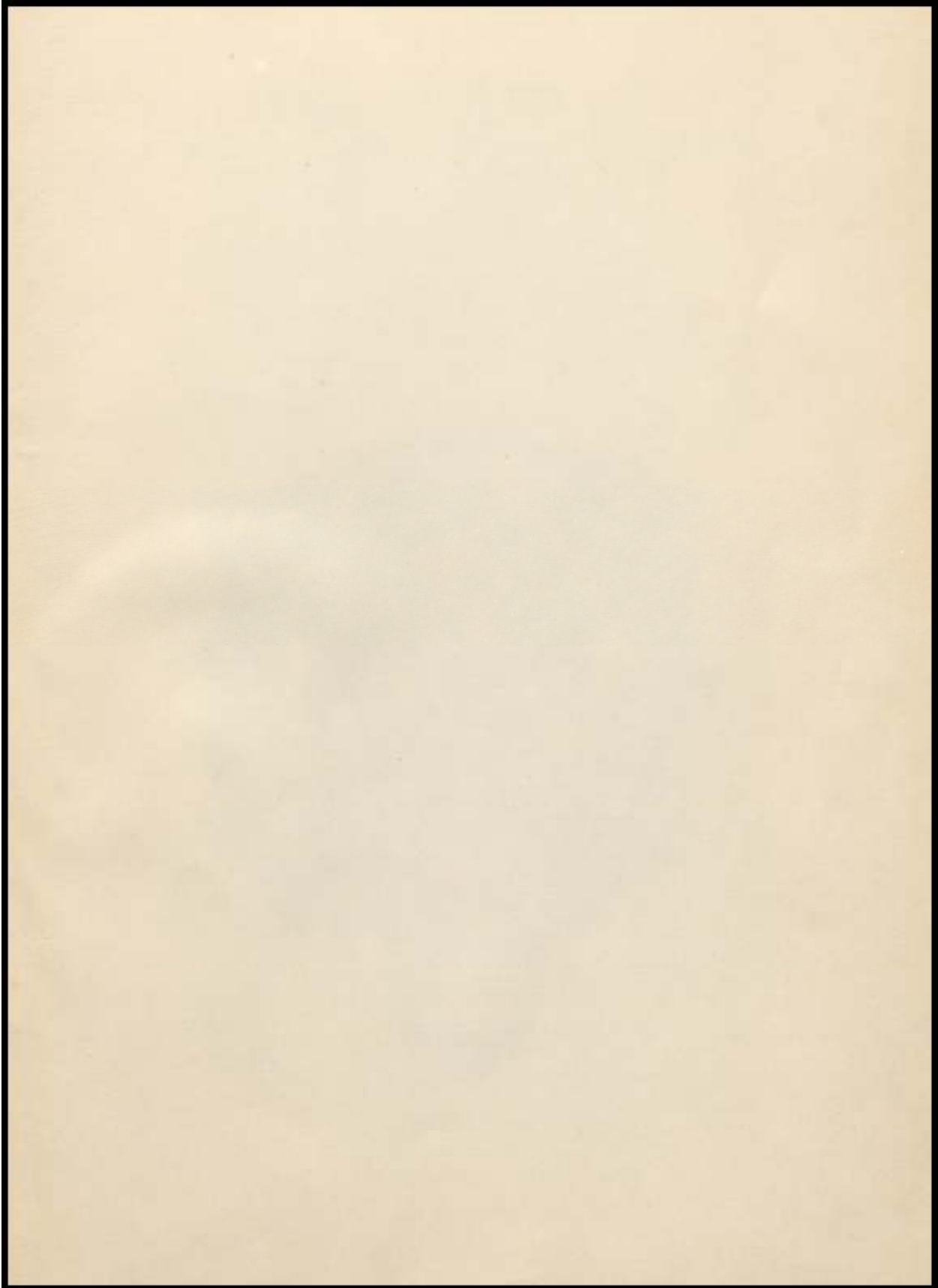
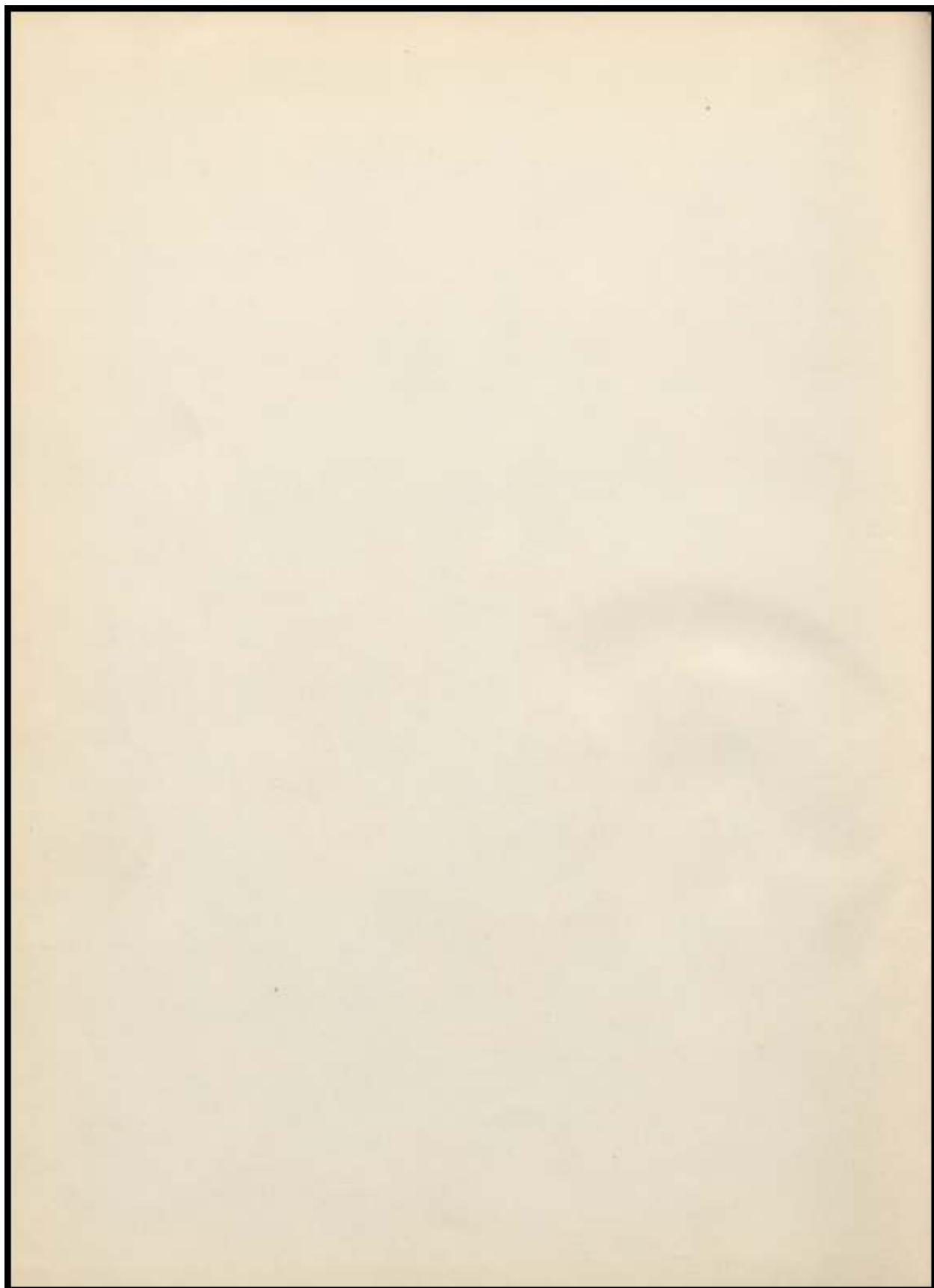

## Class History

In the fall of 1939, six girls and nine boys became the main spokes of the first grade wheel. These were: Lyle Aasheim, Morton Christianson, Ruth Christianson, Beverly DeSchmidt, Joan Hilbert, Robert Knutson, Orlin Olson, David Rolland, Elwood Thompson, Wayne Vaudt, Veloyce Espe, LeRoy Courtney, Janice Kinseth, Gene Miller, and Delrose Ries. Lillian Winger was the one to teach us the fundamentals of school life.

At the end of the year these spokes separated, but came back again the next fall to again join hands to form the wheel of grade two. We lost Lyle Aasheim, Veloyce Espe, Joan Hilbert, and gained Robin Rolland, Vernen Pflibsen, Stanley Jensen, Robert Ellingson. We now had sixteen bars on our grade wheel and we rolled along through the second grade with Bernice Estenson as our guide.

Our third grade wheel was steered by Myrtle Lerud, and this year we added Phelva Berge and Arnold Bratland to our class but we suffered a loss of eight students, namely: Morton Christianson, Gene Miller, Robert Knutson, LeRoy Courtney, Delrose Ries, Wayne Vaudt, David and Robin Rolland.

We remained in the same room and under the same leadership throughout the fourth grade. We lost Beverly DeSchmidt, but increased our total number by two when we added Howard Bringman, Jerry Christianson and Daisy Cochran.

In the year, 1943, we moved across the hall to the fifth grade room. We were led on with superior guidance by Ivanell Larson. This year we found Stanley Jensen had left us, and in the mid-year Harlan Sundermeyer left us also. However, another member, Dorothy Theesfeld, was added to us.

As we advanced to the sixth grade we found our little circle joined by Bill Hastings. Again we were under Ivanell Larson's protecting hand.

In the seventh grade we found things to be much harder but we seemed to like the monitor system and were haughty to think the teachers were depending upon us. We were also very proud to say that we were junior high students. We gained James Hanson, but lost three other members, Arnold Bratland, Howard Bringman, and Daisy Cochran. Mona Tullis pushed us through grade seven.

Our last year in grade school was a happy one. Our wheel had fewer rays than when we first entered school. We now had three girls and six boys because James Hanson and Dorothy Theesfeld had joined another wheel in other schools. Lois Torkelson joined us in the latter part of the year. We graduated from grade school in the spring of 1947. Miss Marion Helland was our teacher.

Finally, we advanced up the steps into the high school assembly and became green Freshmen. There are now sixteen spokes on our Freshman wheel for many students from the country schools came in to join us. The members of our class were: Fern Adams, Phelva Berge, Ruth Christianson, Jerry Christianson, Robert Ellingson, William Hastings, Mildred Jensen, Marilyn Johnson, Janice Kinseth, Orlin Olson, Vernen Pflibsen, Lawrence Sharkey, Harlan Sundermeyer, Elwood Thompson, Lois Torkelson, and Marjorie Wiuff. Fortunately, we all survived the rigors of initiation--tomato throwing, egg throwing, and what have you. Mr. Schar was our class sponsor.

We were promoted to Sophomores and so were given the honor of initiating another class of green Freshmen. Also, we all served as waiters and waitresses for the Junior-Senior banquet. We found that Marilyn Johnson and Janice Kinseth had left our class. Mr. Siebsen was chosen as our class sponsor.

The next year we assembled as Juniors. We found one member, Larry Sharkey, missing. This year kept us quite busy. We presented our class play, "Desperate Ambrose" under the direction of Mr. Dale Vige. We added Iola Jacobson, LeRoy Jacobson, and Mary Kraabel to our circle. Also, Orlin Olson who had left the preceding summer again joined us. We put on the Junior-Senior banquet with the theme "Moonlight Flower Garden" under the able supervision of Miss Carrie Adamson. Lois Torkelson left us in the latter part of the year.

On August 28, 1950, we became the main wheel of Bode High. Mr. Schar is again our class sponsor. On October 28th we journeyed to Storm Lake to have our graduation pictures taken. Now we are all looking forward to our Skip Day, Senior Day, Class Play, and the Junior-Senior Banquet. On May 18, 1951, sixteen Seniors will graduate from Bode High School. These will be: Fern Adams, Phelva Berge, Jerry Christianson, Ruth Christianson, Robert Ellingson, William Hastings, Mildred Jensen, Mary Kraabel, Orlin Olson, Vernen Pflibsen, Harlan Sundermeyer, Elwood Thompson, Marjorie Wiuff, Iola Jacobson, LeRoy Jacobson, and Lois Torkelson.
