In Mr. Perrin's group were Janice Christianson, Mary Christianson, Marilyn Gjeffe, Clifford Gelland, Floyd Johnson, Roger Jensen, Robert Nasby, Ruth Pederson, Roger Songved, Marlin Torgerson and Wilfred Wuiff. The jungle had claimed Darwin Dipple.

When we were in the eighth grade we were sent up to the back of the assembly to see how the members of the older pack ran their lives. Here we saw and heard and really got some good ideas as how to act. That year we won the Junior High Runner up trophy in the Boone Valley Junior High Basketball tournament. This year we gained Gary Engel and Mary Rhoads. Mr. Norman B. Theiss was our coach and teacher.
