Class History

On September 4, 1944, twelve bright-eyed youngsters were herded into their first classroom by their teacher, Marquerite Oppedahl. This class consisted of Carol Ann Johnson, Sandra Holden, Nancy Hoover, Barbara Opheim, Jo Ann Nasby, Faye Hanson, Donald Christianson, Robert Rolland, Dennis Vaag, Elvin Williams, Wendell Kinseth, and Miles Hanson.

We struggled through our first year with only three casualties. They were Carol Ann Johnson, Wendell Kinseth and Miles Hanson; however, we did gain two more demons of knowledge our second year. They were Roger Andrews and Noel Trygstad. This second grade commenced on September 3, 1945 under the guidance of Marguerite Oppedahl.

On September 2, 1946, we were welcomed by a new teacher, Erma Straube. We lost Faye Hanson, Noel Trygstad, Elvin Williams, and Roger Andrews. We gained Lois Sween in November of that year. We were now down to eight members.

In our fourth year we were again greeted by a new teacher, Joan Laubenthal. Along the way we had lost Donald Christianson. We gained Sandra Helmen and John Pederson.

Six new faces greeted these nine members in fifth grade. They were Farrell Cooper, Edward Hanson, Richard Helvick, Keith Jensen, Edward Johnson, and Jerrold Hood. This made our class total fourteen. We had lost John Pederson. Our teacher this year was Mrs. Charles Siebsen.

By our sixth year we were used to this daily routine. We were half way through our formal education. We gained Wilbur Johnson this year. Our teacher was Marilyn Fevold.

We were ushered across the hall the next year. Our teacher for the seventh year was Miss Michelson. We had gained Marlys Brauman, but lost Jo Ann Nasby and Wilbur Johnson. We now numbered fourteen.

Finally we reached our last year in grade school. Our teacher this year was Flora Stroud. Those graduating from the eighth grade were Marlys Brauman, Sandra Holden, Sandra Helmen, Nancy Hoover, Wilbur Johnson, Barbara Opheim, Robert Rolland, Lois Sween, Dennis Vaag, Farrell Cooper, Edward Hanson, Richard Helvick, Keith Jensen, Edward Johnson, and Jerrold Hood.

On September 1, 1952, we entered high school as green little freshmen. We were subjected to all kinds of teasing, but we enjoyed it. We had gained or lost no one. We now had to get used to more than one teacher.

By the time we were sophomores we enjoyed high school. All we could think about was our graduation day. This year we gained Dwaine Du Bois and Jack Harrison. We now had a class of seventeen.

Our junior year was high lighted by winning first prize on our homecoming float. We liked nothing better than to top the seniors. Our class was now down to fourteen. We had lost Dwaine Du Bois, Wilbur Johnson, and Jerrold Hood.

Our last and final year had finally arrived. We were now Seniors. Every day that went by was another step closer to the big day. We had lost Richard Helvick, but gained Rollene Hanson. The graduating class of 1956 numbers fourteen. They are Farrell Cooper, Edward Hanson, Jack Harrison, Keith Jensen, Edward Johnson, Robert Rolland, Dennis Vaag, Marlys Brauman, Sandra Helmen, Sandra Holden, Nancy Hoover, Barbara Opheim, Lois Sween and Rollene Hanson.
