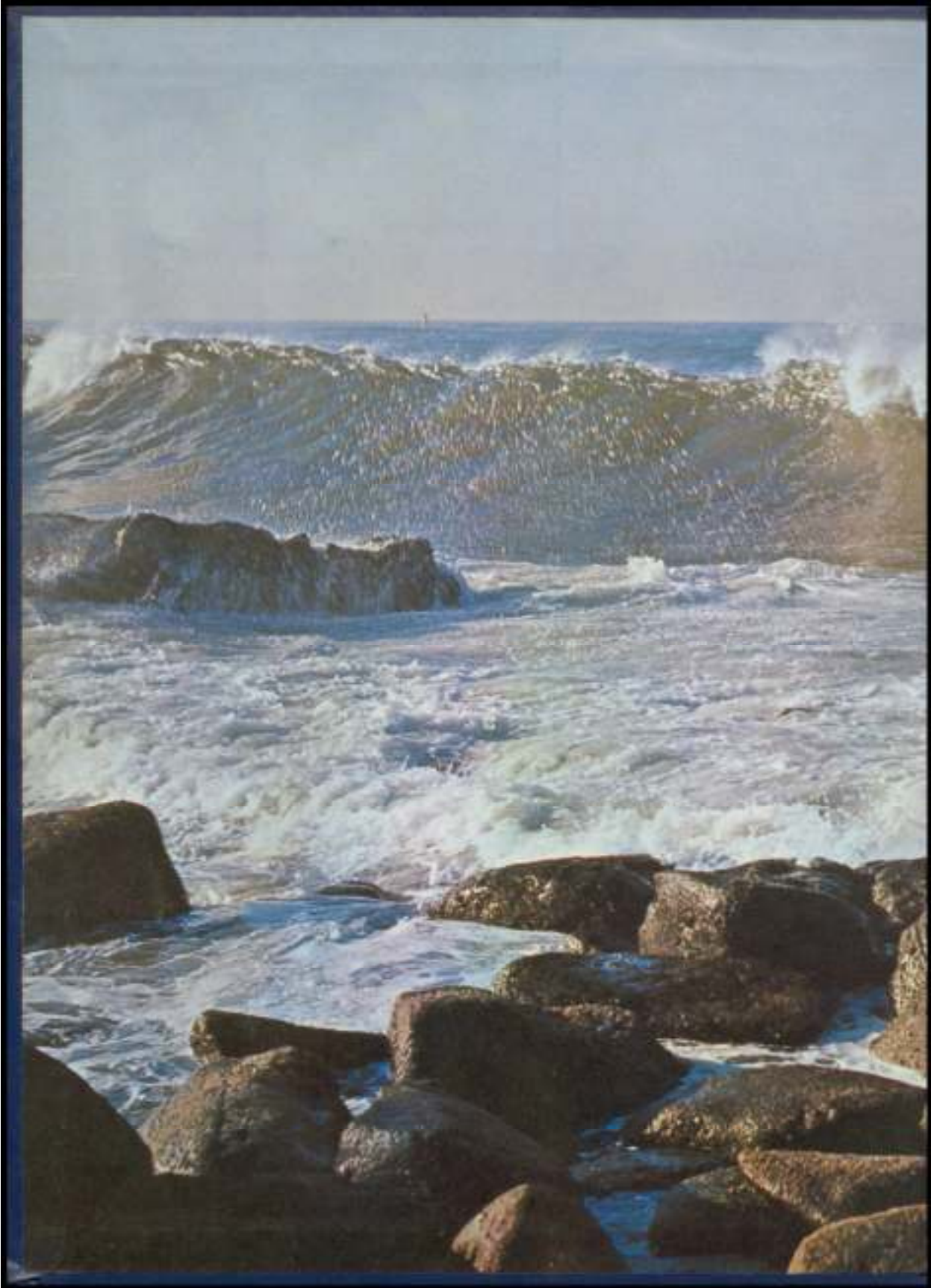
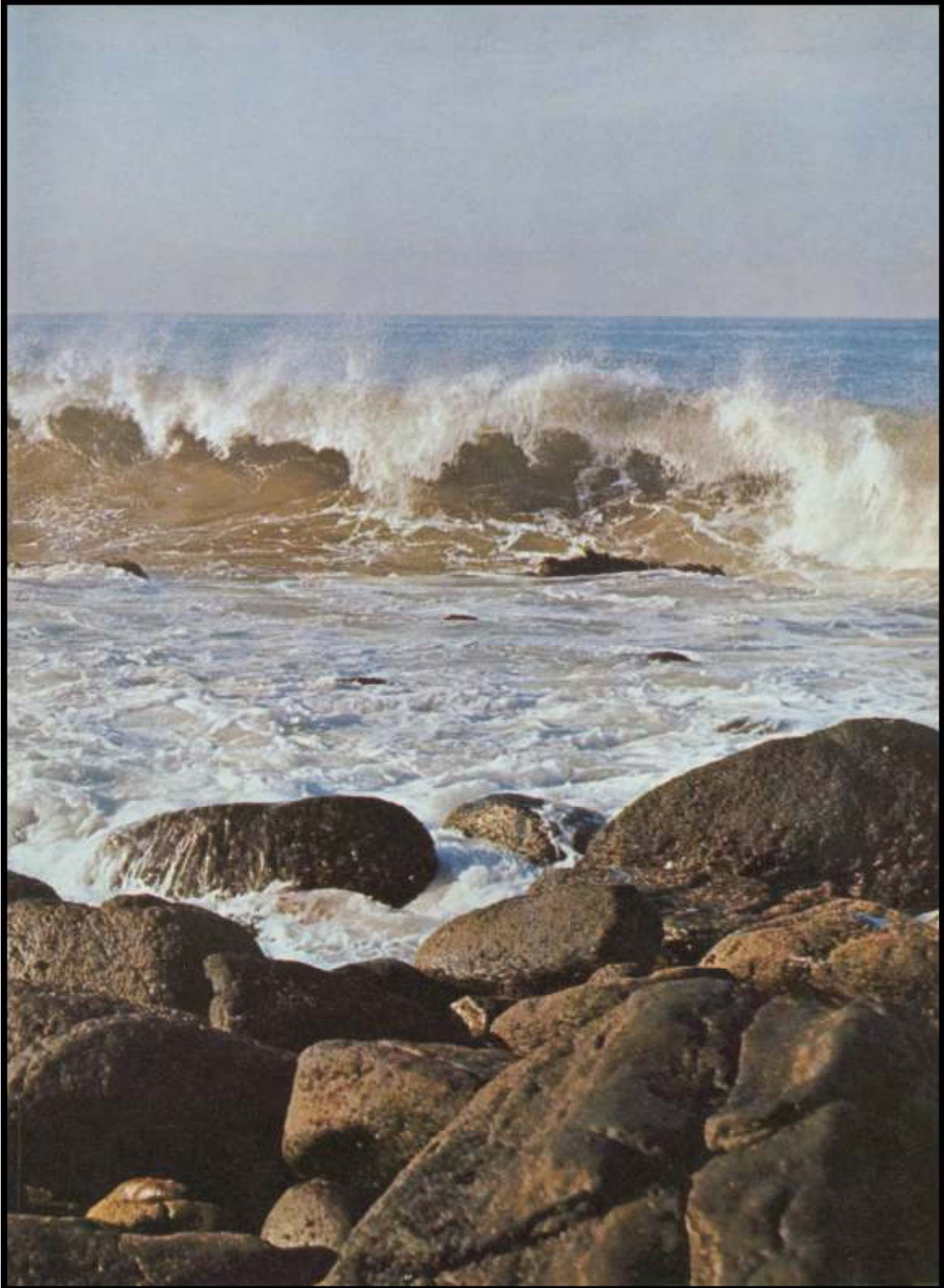


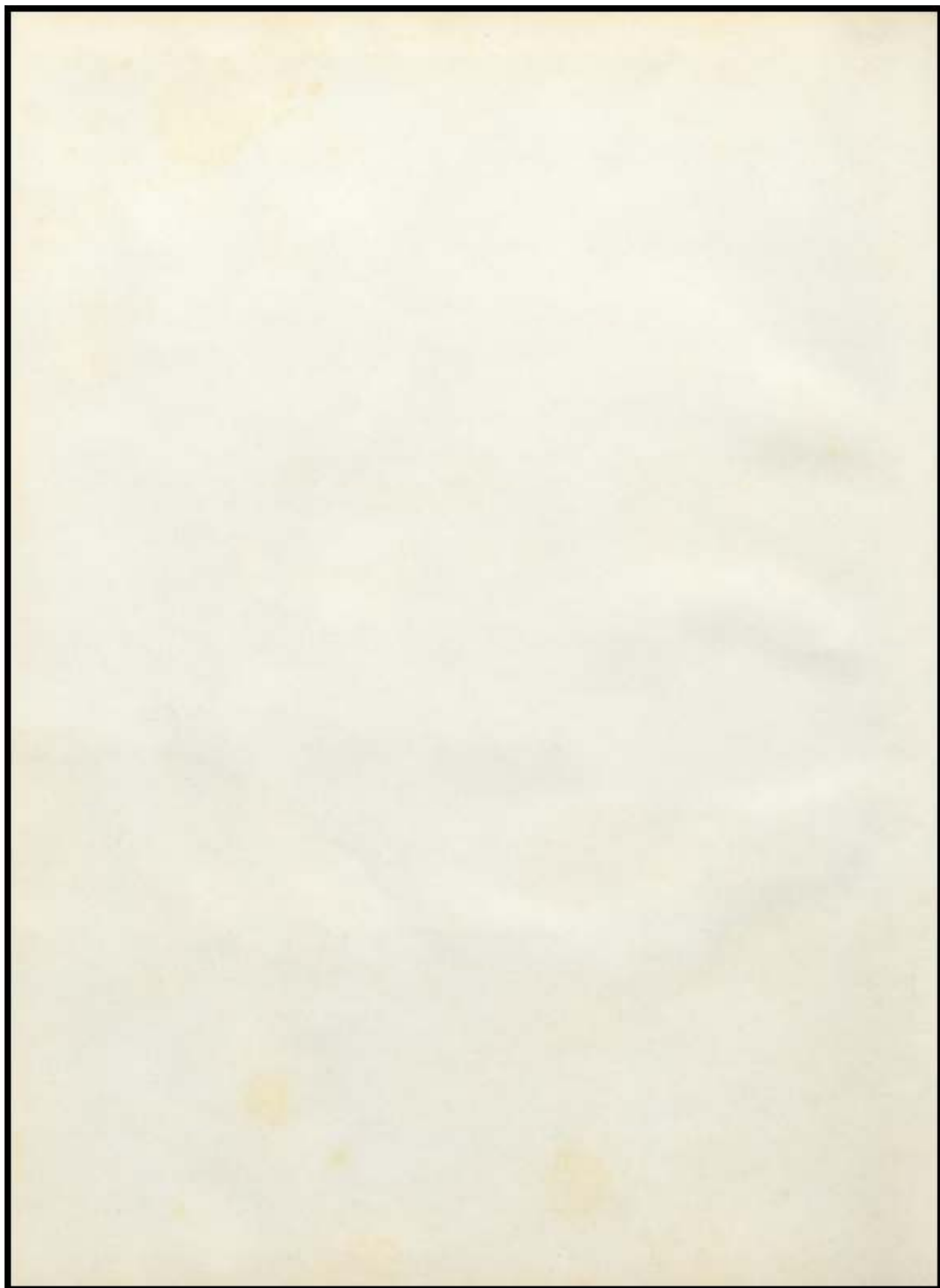

IN MEMORIAM



We, the Senior Class of 1957, would like to acknowledge Mr. Cookrill's many endeavors in education. His friendship, guidance, and image certainly have inspired us during our school days.

Lowell E. Cookrill was born on July 24, 1898, at Edgerton, Missouri, the third of seven children born to James A. and Allie Walters Cookrill. He attended rural school and spent four years in private academies. The last two years of preparatory work were taken at William Jewell College, Liberty, Missouri. He then enrolled in North East Missouri State Teachers College, Kirksville, Missouri, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in 1918. It was here he met and later married Anne Josephine Lillard. Lowell Cookrill had forty-four years of teaching experience. One year in his home rural school at Platte City, Missouri. He taught three years at Ottumwa, Iowa, as high school principal and superintendent. Seven years he served as superintendent at Weldon, Iowa. He came to Livemore in August, 1937, as superintendent, where he served for twenty-nine years. He spent the last four years of his teaching career at Livemore when the new Twin Rivers Community School District consisting of Bode, Ottosen, and Livemore was organized. The last school year he was at the Twin Rivers High School at Bode serving as high school library supervisor. He retired at the end of the school year. He had 499 high school graduates in twenty-nine years at Livemore High School.
