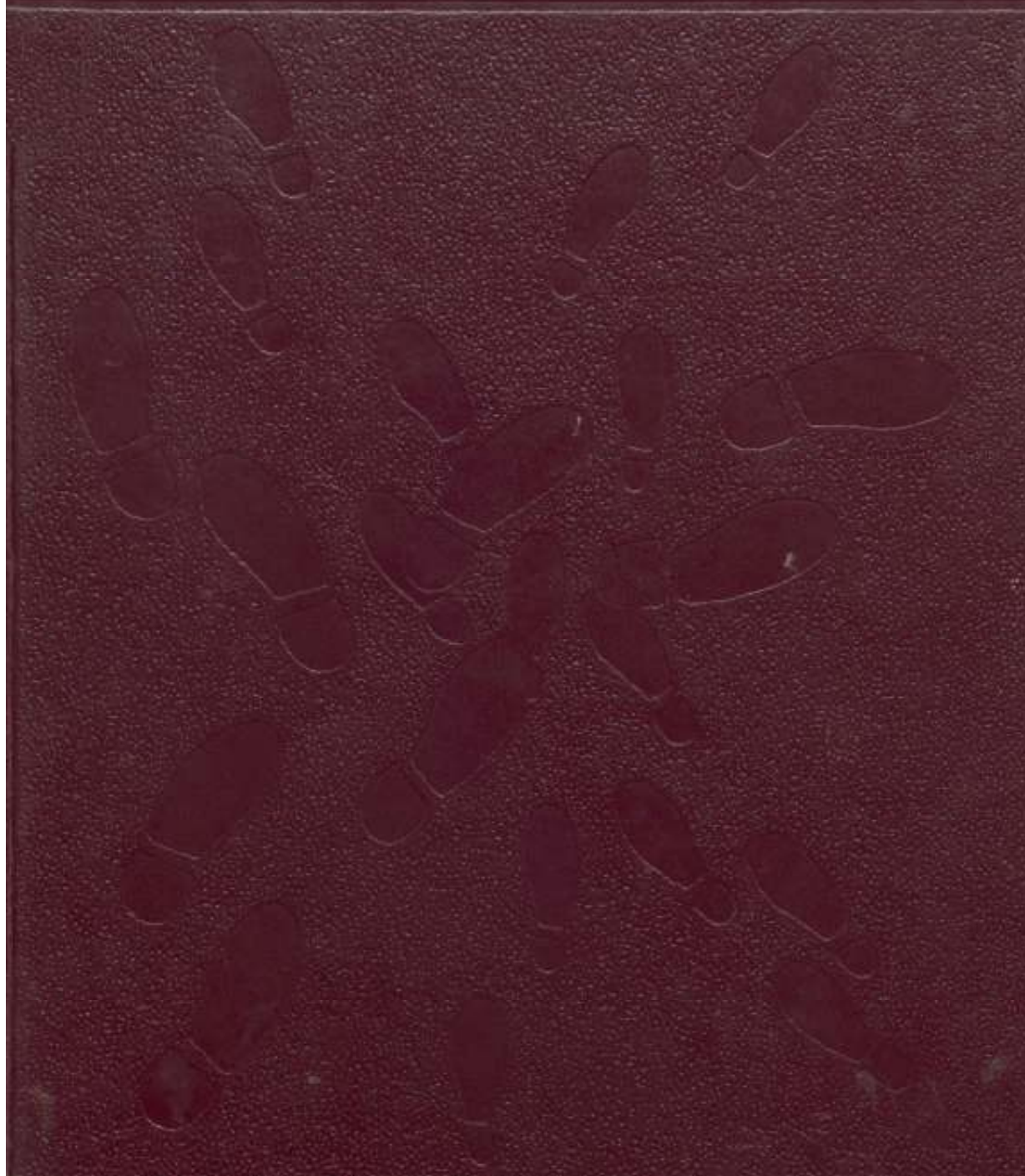

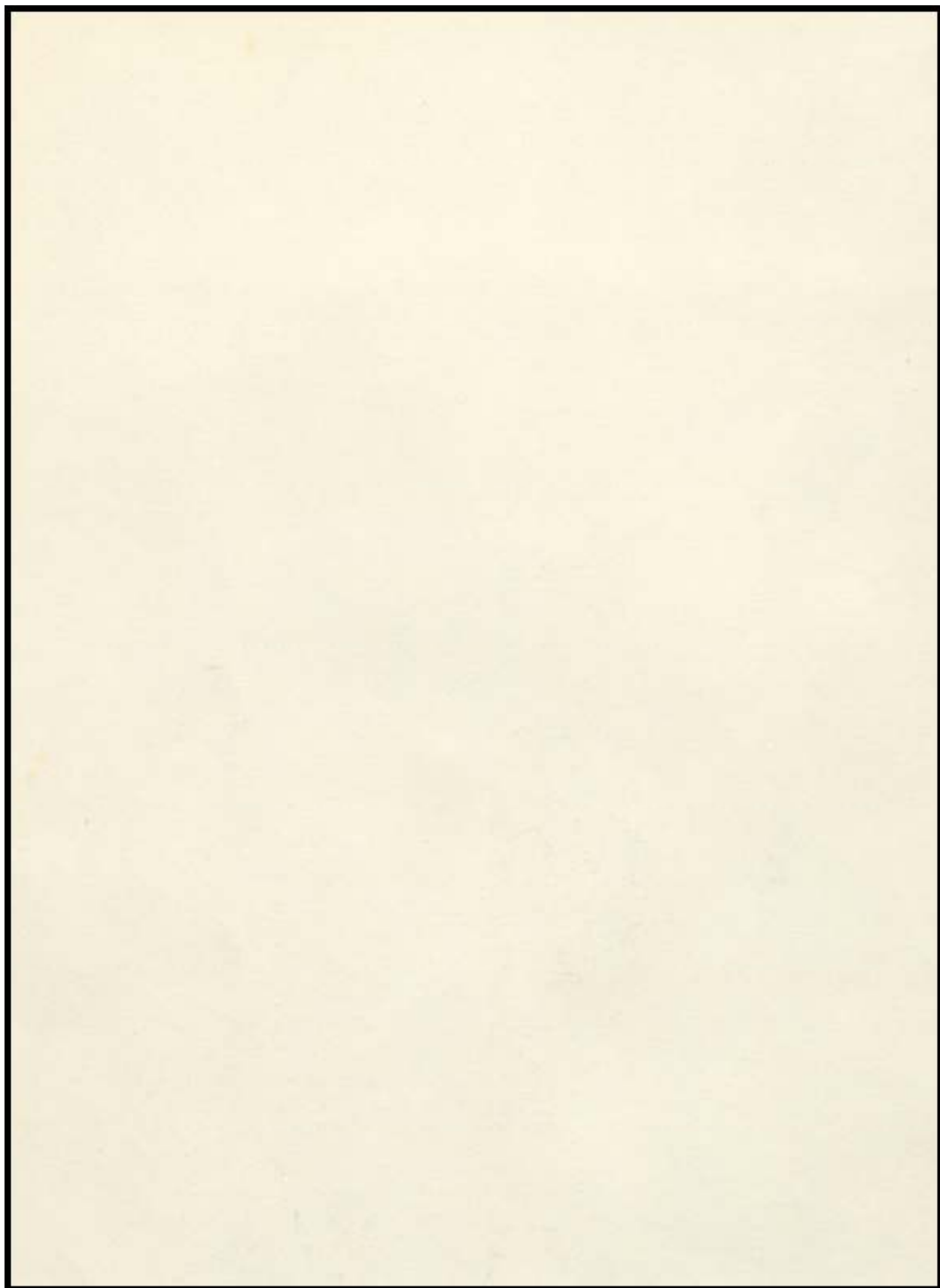

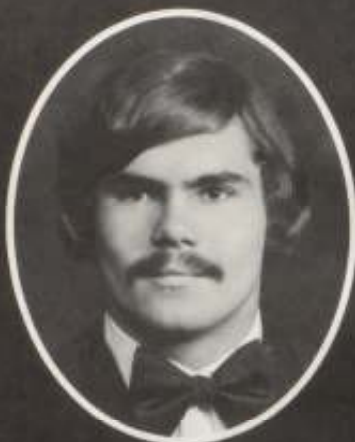

The 1974 football season proved to be more satisfying than the last couple seasons in the two-loss column. We were only one win away from being conference champions in a very tough Twin Lakes Conference. This year the conference had six teams capable of winning the title, finally shared by Manson and Pocaterra.

Our team came back to two practices a day in good condition and with an excellent attitude. With hard work and some vocal encouragement from the coaches, our physical condition became one of our strong points as evidenced by the Piratas outscoring their opponents 59 to 17 in the fourth quarter for the year.

Our offense improved immensely due mostly to the increased experience of people at the skill positions - ends and backs. Coach Nelson was in charge of these positions and did an excellent job. Our line blocking improved considerably from the 1973 season and enabled us to run and to pass when we wanted. Our pass blocking was perhaps the most improved aspect of team play.

Defensively, we were improved when everyone was healthy, but suffered injuries to some key personnel and from mid-season on became quite porous. Needless to say, we will have to do a great deal of improving in this area next year. One very encouraging statistic, is that we allowed only one touchdown pass against us all year.

We will miss our five graduating seniors: Bruce Foth, Alvin Berte, Bruce Bratland, Dave Kiley, and Dean Coleman. Their leadership, desire, and ability played a very large part in our success this year. However, our next year's outlook is encouraging with fifteen returning lettermen.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the assistant coaches - Will Nelson, Al Schonbeck, and Herb Roney for a job well done. Also the cheerleaders, student body, faculty, alumni, friends, and parents deserve to be thanked for their support. The coaches and players greatly appreciated this support.

#### Varsity Boys' Basketball

This year's "Pirates" had a very successful season high-lighted by winning a state of the Twin Lakes Conference Championship, the first since the 1958-59 season. Their 14-4 record was the best season (postwar) since ever for a Twin Rivers boys' team. They lead the conference in offense with 1,018 total points, and a 72.6 per game average. While they were upset in sectional play, the young "Pirates" won many "big" games, and defeated every team they played at least once.

Individually, T.R. was lead by Greg Lempe's 243 rebounds, Rich Kinsett's 394 total points, Terry Johnson's 53% shooting from the field, and Vig Hauke's low number of turnovers. Senior starter Dave Kiley played well all season, and ran the offense from his point guard position. His fellow senior Daryl Olson contributed much to the team's success through his spot play and practice competition.

Prospects for next year look bright with eleven juniors and five sophomores returning to vie for varsity positions. This is especially true if these young men continue to maintain the desire to be winners they have displayed in the past.

As coach, I want to thank the guys for making it a fun year by their play on the court and behavior off the court.
