MUD SCENE — The Red Cross joined the rescue effort at Columbia after Nelson de Maza volcano erupted, causing a mud slide that killed 20,000.

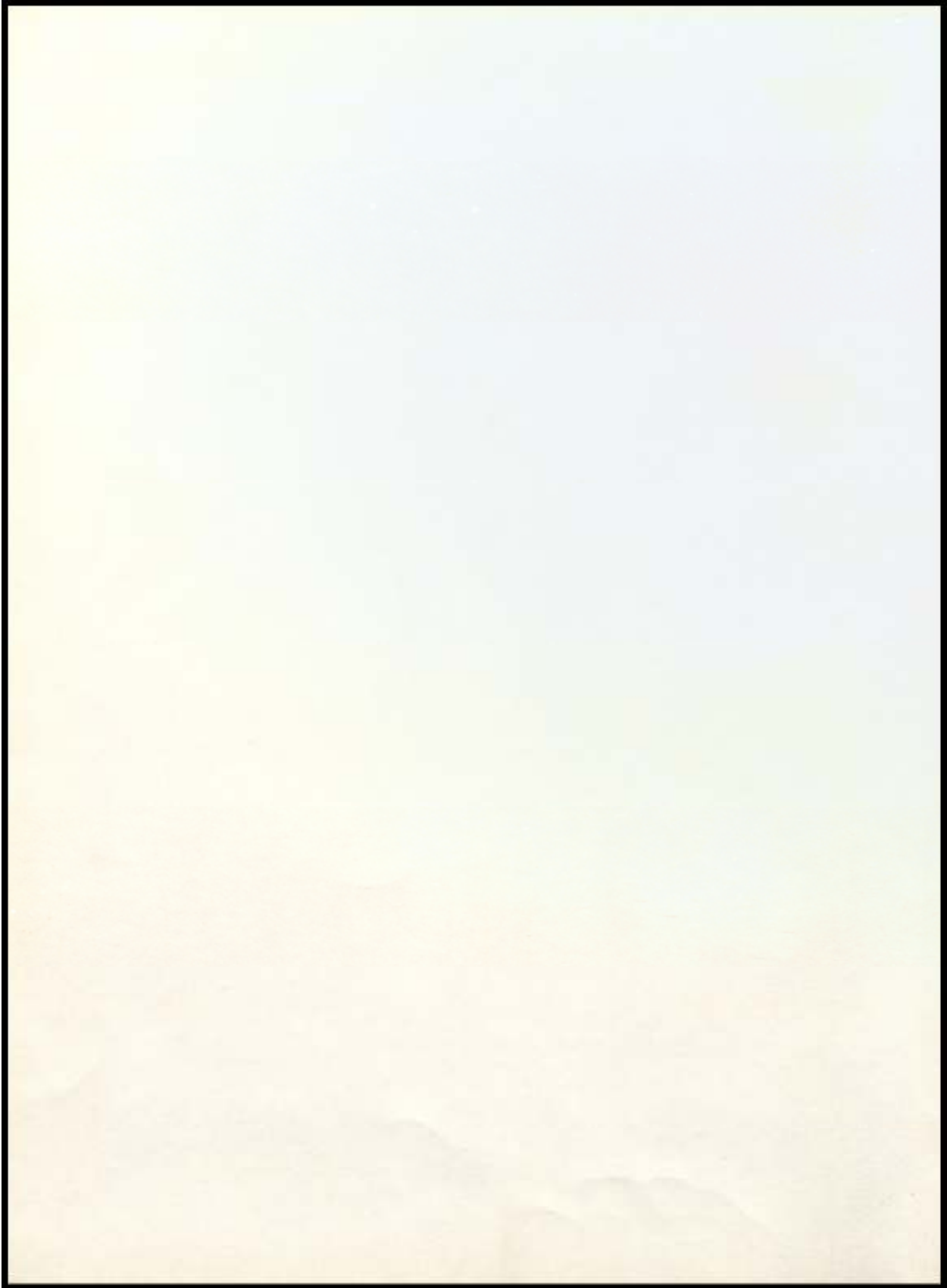
WORLD SERIES — Brian Lintner led the Kansas City Royals to victory in the World Series. Lintner appeared in five games and was named MVP for the Series.

REAGAN — President Reagan, with his wife Nancy, gave the A-10 key ring from his hospital window after undergoing surgery to remove a cancerous tumor.

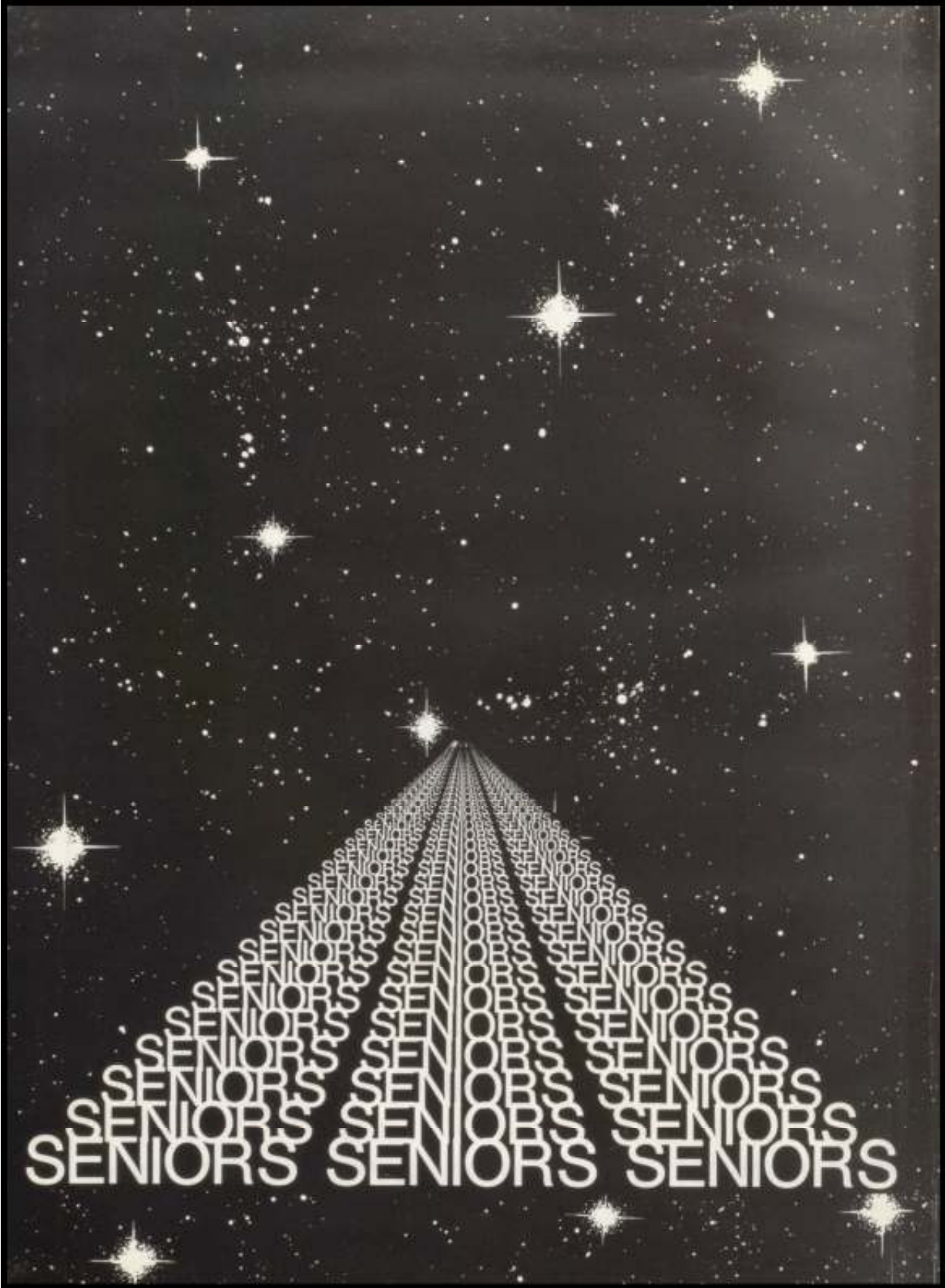
WARRIORS — Several great stars of stage and screen died during 1985, among them Orson Welles, T.O. Rock Hudson, and Ted Dwyer, Jr.

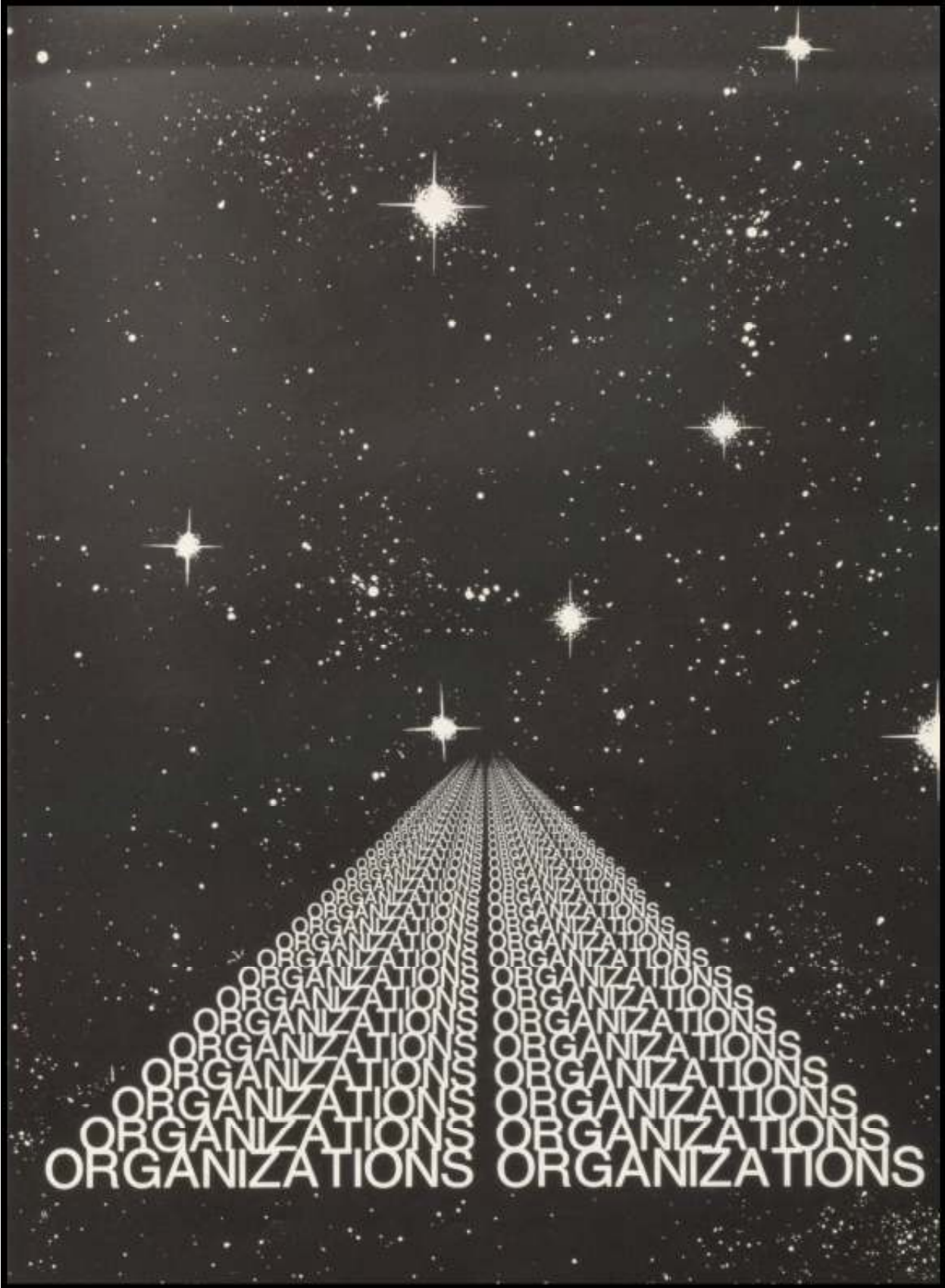

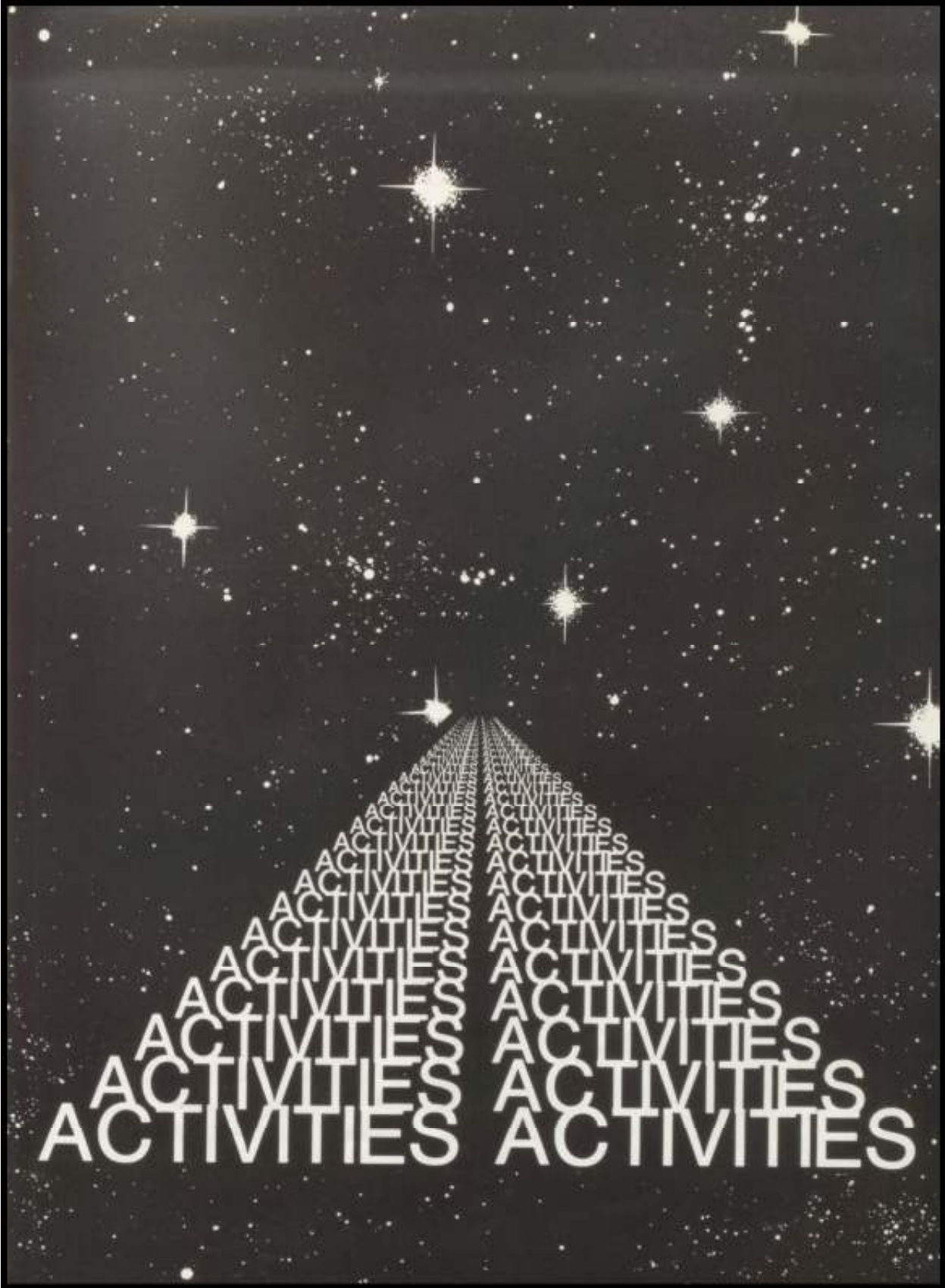

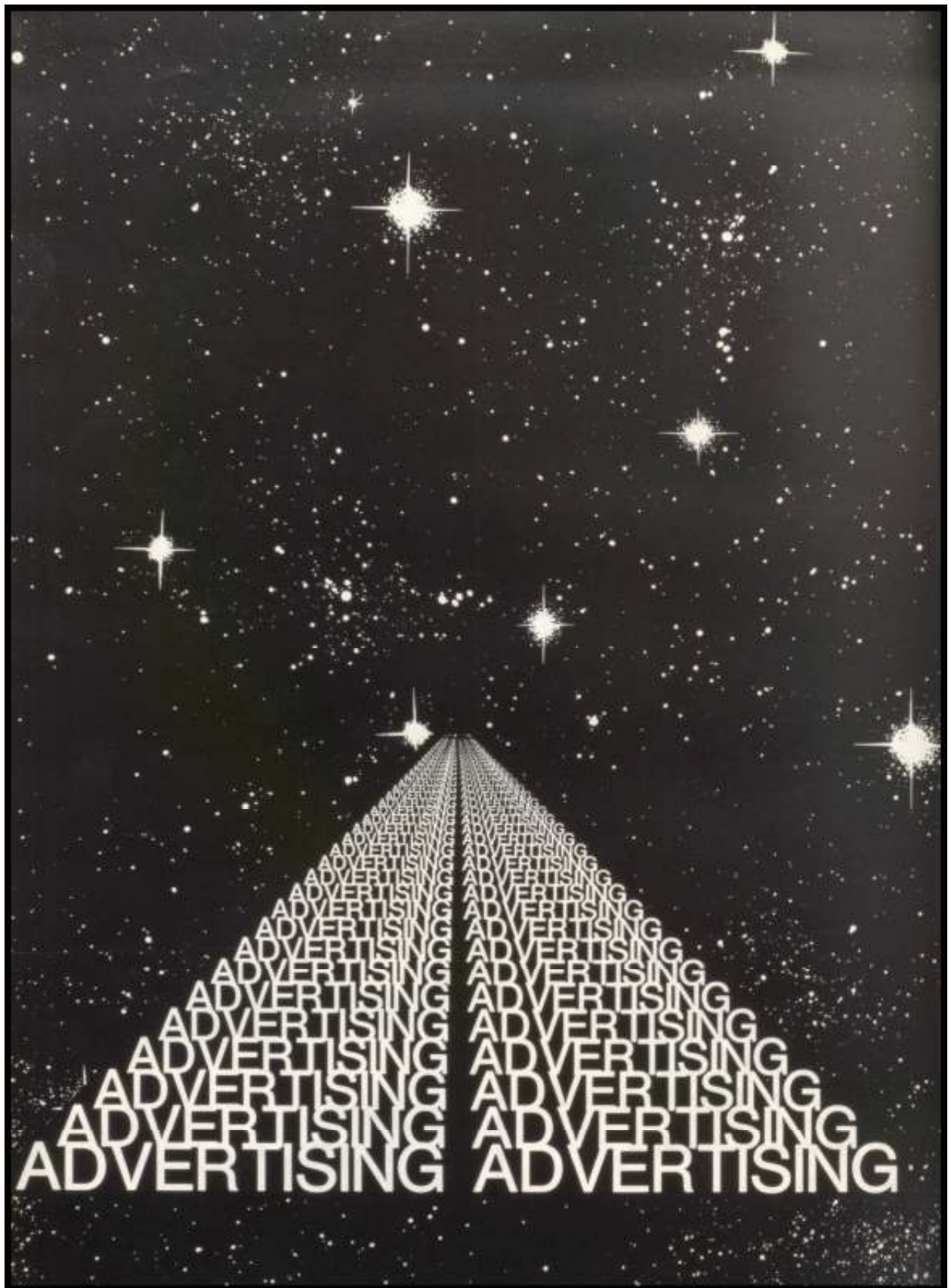
