Tuesday, they had a morning walk to the Santa Prisca Church, with the afternoon for silver shopping. On Wednesday they ate a hearty breakfast before a four hour drive to Acapulco. On Thursday the only required thing was to eat some breakfast. The rest of the day was left open.

Finally on Friday morning they ate their last meal in Mexico before heading to the Acapulco Airport for their flight home. They arrived in Bode at 2:30 a.m. Saturday morning.
