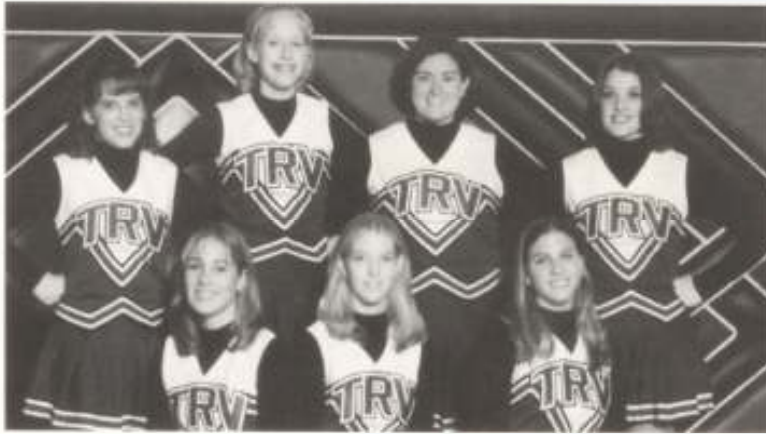

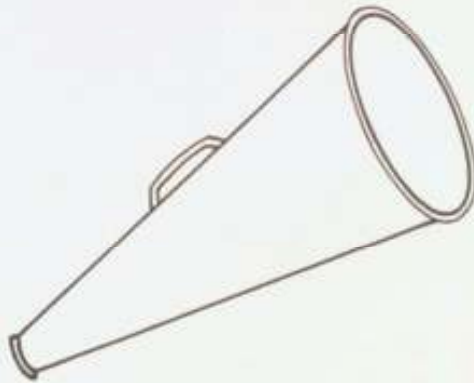

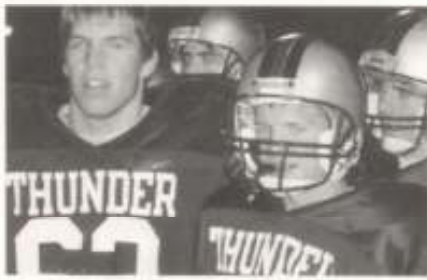
The 1997-1998 Thunder softball team was headed by coach Shelly Watnem. They finished the season with a 4-4 record in the conference, and a 10-20 record over all.

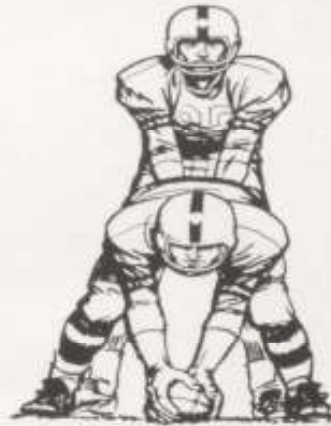

The Thunder boys basketball had much rebuilding this year with only two seniors and four freshman. "This season gave a lot of experience to all the players," said Coach Johnson.

The upperclassmen led the team along with some new faces. Seniors Derek Lanning averaged 9 points per game and Joel Zeman averaged 6 points per game. 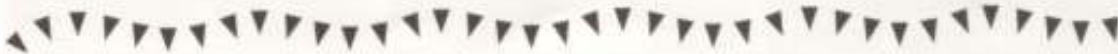
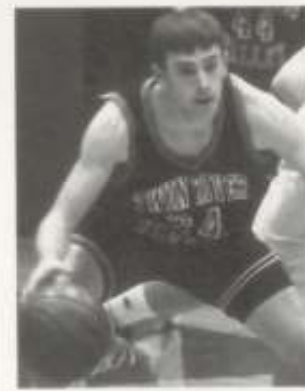

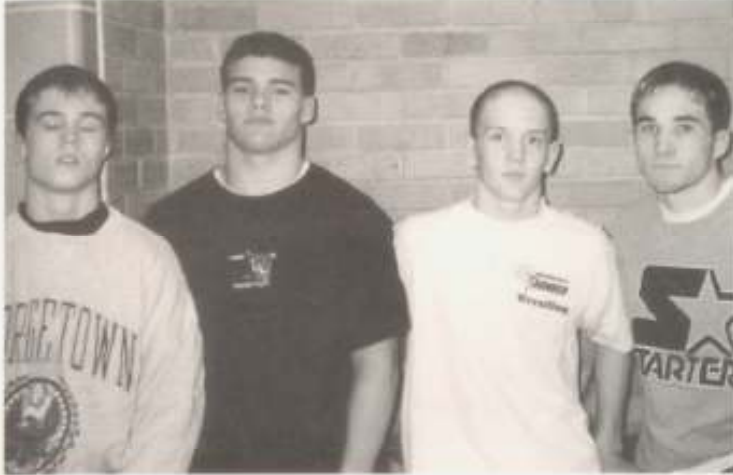
The Thunder Wrestling team had a successful season this year placing first at sectionals and having an overall record of 13-14-1.

Throughout the year the Drill Team performed at Basketball games, Football games, Eagle Groves drill team night, and also performed during several parades.

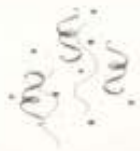
